

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; 1/2 Level; Reopening)
lead suggestive
can be weak as jump overcalls are 2 suited
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 except in 4th; reopening=11-14
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
2 suited=cue of opponent's suit is 2 non touching suits
Jump in suit = that suit and next touching
DIRECT AND JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)
cue raises on partner's overcalls
jump bid by non passed hand = splinter
jump bid by passed hand = fit showing
VS. NT (vs. Strong/ Weak; Reopening; PH)
over strong NT: 2♣ = majors; 2♦, ♥, ♠ = transfer; double = penalties
over weak NT: as above
EXCEPT in 4th position all becomes natural
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT bids)
Double = T/O
Cue bid = 2 suited
NT = natural
Jumps - 2 suited
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
Over strong 1♣: double = majors; 1NT = minors
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Natural
